Please be advised that the San Diego and Imperial Counties Labor Council's Executive Board has approved your Strike request of behalf of AFSCME Local 3299, and your nearly 24,000 members at the University of California's 10 Campuses and 5 Health Systems. It is sad to hear that impasse has been reached after 14 months of bargaining. Even more concerning is the attacks on worker pensions, seniority rights and contracting out jobs.
